

The 1st Eclipse Patterns of 2005

Aries is the first sign of the Zodiac Flat Wheel. It is the strongest fire sign. At the time of an Aries Eclipse, draw your attention to yourself.

The poet Kabir urged looking within...

“You were born on Earth as human,
Why are you in slumber now?
Take care of yourself;
Yourself is what you have to know.
The learned pundit gives discourse,

Aries is a cardinal sign meaning it likes beginnings and initiates action. The seeds of our intentions are planted at the New Moon time. What do you want to grow and nurture within yourself? In the book, *The Keys of Enoch*, we are reminded “The divine seed, even expressed as human, has been created to exist as a dynamic life force, to experience the many levels of universal Godhood within the divine plan...”

The Aries symbol represents a fountain of life. Energy that pulses with vibrancy bursting with sparks of light. “For with you is the fountain of life; in your light we see light.” Psalm 36:9. Do you reflect an enthusiasm for life? If not, take this time to assess what holds you back from being in your full expression of your light?

Connie Kaplan writes in her book, *The Invisible Garment*, that the spiritual principle for the 19th degree of any sign is Service. “Service is a state of consciousness, a state of being, not an action or state of doing. How much love can one being express? How much light can one being carry? How much truth can one being speak?”

In rounding up the Aries Eclipse degree to 20°, her description at this degree point for a spiritual principle is “Gratitude.” She describes gratitude as “the deep understanding that life is a gift, not a burden or assignment.”

The Aries New Moon Solar Eclipse occurs on April 8th, 2005 at 4:32 p.m. at 19° ♈ 06′. Over the next 6 months, focus on embracing a new identity of yourself. See yourself engaging in exciting new possibilities.

The Scorpio Full Moon Lunar Eclipse occurs on April 24th, 2005 at 6:06 a.m. at 4° ♏ 20′. At the time of the Lunar Eclipse, what can be illuminated is the need to release old beliefs and patterns that limit you or hold power over you. This is a time to identify your core issues.

7th House	Identify what a balanced relationship means to you	What ways do you go overboard in focusing on what others need or want? Do you do things you don't really want to do because you can't say "no."
8th House	Identify social values	Do you identify with social values and not enough with your own value system? Do you resist change? If so, how?
9th House	Identify your current beliefs	Are your beliefs what you truly believe? Do you remain with an out-dated belief system from your youth? What is your idea of God now?
10th House	Identify professionalism	Do you stand up for yourself at work? Do you honor the unique way you need to perform your work? Are you overly concerned with what others will say or think about you?
11th House	Identify social consciousness	Are you able to connect well with other people? Are you overly influenced by friends and their opinions?
12th House	Identify your perceptions of being a mystical being	Do you avoid spending quiet, meditative time with yourself, unplugging from others and the busy aspects of life? What fears are carried to the present from your past?
