

2nd Eclipse Patterns of 2005

The New Moon/Libra Solar Eclipse was at 6:28 a.m. on Monday, Oct. 3rd at 10° \pm 19'.

The Full Moon/Aries Lunar Eclipse will be at 8:14 a.m. on Monday, Oct. 17th at 24° \mp 13'.

The New Moon is a time to set intentions. The Full Moon is a culminating point of energies in the Lunar cycle. With the light offered at the time of the Full Moon, we can often see insights into our shadow issues which offers an opportunity to emotionally release what no longer serves a purpose in our lives. The Eclipse energies are available to work with over the next several months until the next Eclipse patterns in March 2006. There is often a collective shift as well as a personal one.

Eclipses offer an even broader cycle because their patterns typically follow a Saros cycle of 19 years. The look back time in your life would be October of 1986. It's helpful to look at what was happening then to see if you have completed a cycle, have gone off course and/or need to realign yourself with who you are now. Eclipse times are powerful in how they can unsettle us as well as provide a catalyst to bring change into our life.

These particular Eclipses suggest finding ways we can collectively move into maintaining our own equilibrium and harmony while we are in relationship with others. Some timely questions to consider are...

How do you hold your own balance in spite of the external bumps experienced while working or living among different personalities?

What do you want to release that has been a pattern in your relationships that no longer fits for you now?

What do you want more of in your relationships?

We can explore more freedom in our relationships by being our authentic selves. Knowing how you feel and what your heart desires are places to begin this process of being more fully you. This Solar Eclipse invites news way of being in relationship with others. Some intentions to consider...

- 1 I am free to pursue my own dreams and follow my own joys.
- 2 I relish and take comfort in my connection with another.
- 3 I am supportive in empowering another.
- 4 I am responsible in my behavior by being clear in thought and actions in following my own truth.
- 5 I recognize love as my essence. I allow love to flow its own course which sometimes means letting go of a relationship.
- 6 I have a wise and discerning mind in union with a loving heart that I keep in balance in my relationships.
- 7 I discover beauty in others and show appreciation.

Astrological houses are where the energies of the planets and signs express. Divide the sky into twelve sections by drawing imaginary lines. These sections are called houses. Each house has its' activities relating to conditions, environment or situations. Please read the house information which pertains to where the Libra Solar Eclipse and the **Aries Lunar Eclipse** is in your chart. I trust your ability in your own process to understand what you wish to give attention to; nonetheless, I offer a few suggestions for intentions.

1st House ~ *Personality, appearance, the physical body, how others see you, identity*

Set an intention to be true to yourself no matter what!

“Find a way to be comfortable with the world as it is without giving up your own belief system.” (Quotation from Rosalind Shorter, astrologer.)

Release indecisiveness or inadequacies you feel about being in the world and living on Earth.

2nd House ~ *Finances, sense of your self-esteem, values, possessions, talents and resources*

Set an intention to begin a process of being in a new relationship with your body. What physical sensations do you notice offering you clues about your emotions?

Live courageously grounded in your true values.

Release a lack of awareness or disassociation from your body.

Release more of the cultures' values specifically around what you need to have to feel secure.

3rd House ~ *Siblings, short trips, early environment of home & school, early school teachers, communication, how we think*

Set an intention for awareness in new ways of thinking about relationships. Set an intention to communicate your thoughts and feelings as honestly as possible.

Release disorderly thought patterns that keep you from being in harmony within yourself.

4th House ~ *Home, parent, real estate, ending years of your life, early environment in the home*

Commit to being in a new relationship with yourself as your own authority. Find what upholds you to help you maintain a strong sense of yourself. Have the courage to stand apart from your family.

Release ingrained roots from the family matrix keeping you stuck in place.

5th House ~ *Love, passion and romance, children, sports, gambling, creative self-expression, pleasure activities*

Commit to experiencing whatever brings you joy. Honor your pleasures by deepening an awareness of what you feel passionate about.

Commit to healing your own inner wounded child.

Release patterns of avoidance in getting to know your own heart.

6th House ~ *Work, health, routines for diet and exercise, loving service for others, co-workers, employees, habits, wardrobe, pets, health-care providers, professional service people – those you consult re: diet, exercise; co-workers, pets*

Commit to a new relationship enhancing harmony and balance within self.

Analyze what is needed to be fully healthy. Tantric Buddhists say “If you come to know the human body deeply enough, you come to know the entire Cosmos.”

Release suffering by not being fully attentive to what you need for optimal health.

7th House ~ *Marital and business partnerships, interactions with the public, perceived public enemies, legal affairs*

Commit to exploring what a sacred marriage means within yourself.

How do we understand in a deeper perception the following words by Raymond Carver, from “Late Fragment” -

“And did you get what you wanted from this life...? I did.

And what did you want?

To call myself beloved, to feel myself beloved on the earth.”

Release old paradigms that defined relationships.

8th House ~ *Self-mastery, partner’s assets, support received from other people, financial advisors, taxes, inheritances, insurance, secrets, sex, death, ability to regenerate, psychic levels, surgery, sleep, metaphysical realm*

Commit to a process of understanding how to be and live from your core essence.

Release old patterns of not asking for help.

9th House ~ *Religion and philosophical beliefs, laws – earth-made as well as universal, spiritual laws, distant travel, in-laws, super-consciousness realms experienced through dreams or visions, profound mental study, grand-children, intuition, teachers, mentors or guides*

Commit to learning from all of your experiences. Journey within to perceive who guides you.

Release philosophical or religious beliefs that are outdated and don’t reflect you now.

10th House ~ *Profession, social standing in the community, indicates ego, status and reputation, ambition, business and social activities, government, authority, parent, employer, the influence you exert*

Commit to understanding your sense of integrity and how you measure success. Use your gifts to be of loving service to others.

Release fearful behaviors that keep you from expressing your own truth.

11th House ~ *Goals and objectives, hopes and wishes, friends, acquaintances, social groups and alliances related to your career, circumstances in which you have no control over, step-children, foster children and adopted children*

Commit to establishing new group relationships that support you with shared consciousness.

Release any belief in the notion you have control over anything.

12th House ~ *This is the behind-the-scenes area - spiritual initiations, sorrows, hidden strengths and fears, the subconscious mind, karmic hangovers from the past, places of confinement i.e. jails, institutions, hospitals, self-undoing, spiritual debts to be paid, research, clandestine affairs, doctors*

Commit to being in a process of recognizing your hidden strengths.

Release a belief of limitation.
